COVID Requirements

- You will be required to complete the COVID screening questionnaire at registration.
- Entry to the screening area is from 04:30
- No COVID or rapid antigen test is required.
- If you are collecting on behalf of some else, you need to take a copy of the COVID questionnaire for the person to complete and must handed in at the start of the race.
- A temperature check will be done prior to the race (from 04:30), so please arrive early
- Wear your mask until the start of the race, after which it can be removed. You need to
 replace your mask after the race, please request a fresh mask from the COVID officer
 and designated assistants, if you have lost it during the event.
- No spectators-once you have completed the race, please grab your medal and coke and exit the area as quickly as possible.

Please check your race number and if you do not have a valid license number you could purchase temporary license at registration

Seeding

Your race number will have the start batch seeding allocation from A to E. The A group has 450 participants and lower groups have 350. You can change your seeding downwards, however the size of the A -batch has been fully subscribed. You are allowed to start in a lower group should you want to join friends or club mates.

• Start Time:

The race will start at 05:30 with Group A being the first to leave. The groups B to E following thereafter. The last group is expected to leave no later than 05:45.

The cut-off time will be 4 hours -from the time of the last group. A bailer vehicle will be provided to sweep the runners who may not make this cut-off.

• Water

Although this is a "carry your own" event, there will be three water / coke stations along the course

7km water will be provided in cups, as well as in a refill format (flow-bin) for filling up camelback hydration systems.

15km water and coke in cups (refilling of hydration packs with water)

22 Km water will be provided in cups, as well as in a refill format (flow-bin) for filling up camelback hydration systems.

Bringing your own collapsible cup will contribute to reducing the litter produced by the event.

• Parking

Limited parking is available at Maidens Cove The Camps Bay Soccer Club in Argyle Road has been booked for parking with security Off-street parking Bays available along Victoria Road. Please ensure not to block private driveways
