## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. **Online Registration:** [www.RaceTraq.co.za](http://www.RaceTraq.co.za) 01 Aug – 30 Sept 2024 (enquiries [web-query@racetraq.co.za](mailto:web-query@racetraq.co.za)).
2. **Walk-In Registration:** Sportmans Warehouse Canal Walk 06/10/24 from 10h00 – 14h00 and 07/10/24 from 15h00 – 19h00.
3. **Late Registration:** Race Venue 09/10//24 from 15h45 – 18h10.
4. **Number Collection:** Sportsmans Warehouse Canal Walk: 06/10/24 from 10h00 – 14h00 and 07/10/24 from 15h00 – 19h00. At the event collection 09/10/24 from 15h45 till 18h10.
5. **5 km Fun Run/Walk:** Participants younger than 10 years must be accompanied by an adult.
6. Tog bag facilities will be available at runner's own risk.
7. Refreshments will be on sale.
8. Medals to the first 1 200 – 10km finishers and medals to the first 600 – 5km finishers.

### 10km Rules:

9. In addition to Overall (Open) prizes, participants will only be eligible for an age category prize in the age category they enter.
10. Participants may enter the age category corresponding to their chronological age or any younger category down to senior.
11. Temporary licensed participants are eligible for age category prizes provided they enter the relevant age group, wear the appropriate age tags and provide proof of age.
12. Temporary license holders when registering must complete and hand in the tear off strip from the number in order to be eligible to compete. Temporary license runners must wear the race number on the front of their vest and the temporary license on the back.
13. **Juniors (born 2005 or later) must display their category tags ("j") to qualify for age group prizes.**
14. Participants must be 14 years or older to enter the 10km race.
15. 2024 Permanent ASA licenses number must be worn on front and back of their vest. Race Number must be worn on the front of the vest, partially covering the ASA licence, so that the ASA license sponsor remains visible.
16. Licensed athletes should wear club colours. Temporary licensed athletes must run in clothing without advertising.
17. **Stubs on race number, must be in the Athletes possession during the race and handed in at the results board at the finish.**
18. Time limit: 120 Minutes.
19. **5 km Fun Run/Walk:** Participants younger than 10 years must be accompanied by an adult.
20. Results will be posted on [www.wpa.org.za](http://www.wpa.org.za).
21. Any ruling by the race committee will be considered final.
22. Participants must obey instructions from Marshals/Officials.
23. No personal seconding will be permitted, except at official refreshment stations.
24. The use of music players with headphones is not allowed and may result in disqualification.
25. **DISCLAIMER:** Participants in this event do so at their own risk and release and discharge the organisers, sponsors, provincial and national athletics bodies and all persons assisting in staging the event from any responsibility, liability or costs relating to any injury, loss or damage of whatever nature, however caused, arising directly or indirectly from their participation in the event.
26. Wheelchair athletes must please contact the organisers timeously to discuss arrangements for their participation.
27. **PLEASE DO NOT LITTER.** Dispose of sachets and cups responsibly by using the boxes provided or carrying them to the finish. Report offenders to the referee **#RunClean**
